Thank you for volunteering for the Las Vegas Wash Green-Up! As a reminder, you have registered to participate in the planting event scheduled for **Saturday, April 2**. The schedule is as follows:

- **11:45 a.m.** **Volunteers arrive at the parking area**
- **Noon – 1 p.m.** **Free volunteer barbecue lunch**
- **12:15 p.m.** **Planting begins as volunteers finish lunch**
- **4 p.m.** **Planting concludes***

** The event may end earlier depending on the number of volunteers. Volunteers are welcome to leave early if needed. If you are picking up a volunteer at the end of the event, please plan to arrive at about 3:30 p.m.*

Directions:

- Take **US-95** or the **215 Beltway** to **Lake Mead Parkway in Henderson** (exit off the freeway and onto Lake Mead Parkway, which will take you northeast towards Boulder Highway).
- Continue on Lake Mead Parkway, pass Boulder Highway. (If you see Lake Las Vegas, you went too far.)
- Turn **LEFT** on **Mohawk Drive**.
- Turn **LEFT** on **Galleria Drive**.
- Turn **RIGHT** on **McCormick Road**.
- Turn **LEFT** on **Russell Road**.

If using GPS, you may input 1177 Bear Head Street as your destination address, but please follow the signs in the area.

Directional signs will be posted in the area.



If you have difficulty finding the event site, you can call 249-5518 or 743-2332 for assistance.

Each volunteer will receive a commentary Green-Up T-shirt. Please wear appropriate clothing and footwear for outdoor work and consider wearing a hat. Tools will be provided. To save time during check-in, please have each member of your group fill out a release form (enclosed) and bring it to the event.

In the unlikely event of adverse weather, the Green-Up may be postponed for safety reasons. If weather conditions are poor the day prior to the event, please call **822-8543** and check the message for information.
